



A Faithful Sermon Is Biblical

- Preaching communicates that the Bible matters.
- How to read the Bible and be better readers of the Bible.
- How the Bible speaks words of comfort and hope especially now.
- How can our sermons inspire the reading of scripture?

A Faithful Sermon Is Autobiographical

• What comes first? The text or the preacher?

• What do you bring?

 Preacher as rhetorician – one who senses the poignancy of the moment and is able to speak into it.

A Faithful Sermon Is Contextual



- Always the case congregational, communal, national, global.
- Hinge point now before and after COVID-19.
- Liturgical keeper of the church year. Another way to mark time these days.



A Faithful Sermon Is Theological

- Theology as verb and not noun.
- Expand theological imagination: means being open to the specificities of a text's theology.
- We are doing theology here and now, people counting on you – and to help them realize they are theologians as well. They are trying to make sense of what is happening through the lens of belief in God's activity.

A Faithful Sermon Is Intellectual

- A point and a plan.
- What will people remember?
- One of the hardest aspects of crafting a sermon; not only because it is difficult to decide on one claim. But also, risky. The clearer the point, the greater the possibility that someone might disagree with you.
- Challenge new thinking; wonder and discovery.



A Faithful Sermon Is Emotional

- Performance
- Function
- Not just what you say but how you say it.
- John 20:30-31

A Faithful Sermon Is Inspirational

- 2 Timothy 3:16
- The hearers feel as if the very breath of God moves them from worship into the world.
- What can they contribute to experiencing the Kingdom of God here and now.
- Not Sunday-to-Monday transition, but our lives and worship of God integrated and inseparable.
